This document has been prepared as an addendum to various other records associated with the House of Industry (Hof I) Register book and Elmwood Cemetery records. Most of the resident deaths that occurred at the Hof I resulted in the bodies being interred at Elmwood in unmarked graves in a special 'pauper' or 'indigent' area. Periodically, the bodies of the deceased would be reclaimed by family or friends for interment elsewhere in the county. Further, most residents of the Roman Catholic faith would be interred at St. Johns Cemetery just outside Perth, but not always.

The type and format of information contained within existing records also differs. From 1903 to 1935 the cemetery records for indigent burials are almost non-existent or irregular at best and the H of I register was used to collect the data in this document. However, from 1935 onwards the cemetery records are quite accurate for the indigent burials. The attached listing of deaths is focused on recording ONLY those deaths where interment at Elmwood occurred.

After death, burial often occurred within a day, or two at the most, as no embalming was performed. The exception to this was during the winter months when the bodies were stored in the Elmwood vault until the spring. Graves were dug with pick and shovel until the 1960s so the ground needed to be unfrozen before interment. The first very detailed map of Elmwood is framed and preserved at the cemetery office. This map shows the 'pauper' or 'indigent' burial area within section 'C' very distinctly, as the graves are all single and packed very close together; that is literally side by side with no space between them. We do not know for sure, but it is possible that many of the deceased especially in the early



days were just wrapped and bound in a cotton sheet without a casket before interment during the non winter months. Utilitarian flat top pine caskets were probably used consistently sometime in the early 1920s onwards. Further to this, during the spring burials, since numerous bodies would be stored in the vault over the winter, it is highly likely that the remains would be buried two tiers high. As noted earlier, the vast majority of the deceased lie in unmarked graves (no markers or monuments).

Analysis of the burial data from 1903 up to the mid 1960s reveals that almost three hundred indigent interments are contained within the 'paupers/indigent' section of Elmwood. This is an extremely high concentration of remains in this existing small area. That is why we believe that more than one body may be contained within many of the single grave lots. Further to this, because there was no visible demarcation of this mass burial area, we have confirmed that more recent interments encroached over the older indigent graves. If one extrapolates indigent deaths from 1872 when Elmwood opened to 1903 when the H of I opened we can surmise a further 100 indigent burials are contained within this mass burial site for a total of about 400. Since the mid 1960s, indigent burials are randomly placed in normal single burial lots throughout the cemetery but still in unmarked graves. Cemetery records can now pinpoint the exact lot of an indigent burial even without a marker being present.

It is the desire of the writer that some sort of plaque or marker will be placed on this mass burial site in 2016 (Perth's 200th Anniversary) to honor those unfortunate individuals from the H of I that died without any recognizable burial location or marker. Also, it will help future trustee's operating Elmwood to recognize this essentially open area, so as to not disturb it for any further burials.

An (*) indicates spouses only where known. Data sheet #1 1903-1935 was prepared by Eric Halpin from extracts of the House of Industry Register book. Data sheet #2 1935-1965 was collated from Elmwood Cemetery burial register records. Future researchers are advised to reference the source documents for additional information contained therein.

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Several late indigent interments noted by an (**) are included in this list because they appear to be also buried in the common grave area. The normal cemetery practice more recently is that indigent burials are placed in single unmarked grave lots throughout the cemetery grounds.
